THE MARINE PARKS AND RESERVES (USER FEES) (AMENDEMENT) REGULATIONS, 2021

Citation and commencement GN. No. 92 of 2009

- 1.-(1) This Order may be cited as the Marine Parks and Reserves (User Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2021 and shall read as one with the Marine Parks and Reserves (User Fees) Regulations, 2009, hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations".
- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1^{st} day of July, 2021.

Amendment of regulation 3

- **2**. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 3 by adding immediately after subregulation (3) the following:
 - "(4) Concession fee for permission to operate public services as provided for in Item E(i) of the Schedule shall be paid based on the investment categories A, B, C or D specified therein.
 - (5) For purposes of subregulation (4)-
 - (a) Category A = Hotels/lodges with Four-star and above rating;
 - (b) Category B= Three-star rating;
 - (c) Category C= Hotels with Two-star rating, dive centers and other water sports facilities;
 - (d) Category D= Guest houses/ Rest stay/Gift shops/ Restaurants."

Amendment of Schedule

3. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting the Schedule and substituting for it the following:

G: REVENUE SHARING AMONG MPRs AND KEY STAKEHOLDERS:

A portion of net revenue from user fees shall be distributed among the Marine Parks and Reserves and Local Communities in the vicinity of Marine Protected Areas as per Marine Parks and Reserves Act. The distribution percentage shall be as follows:

- (i) Marine Protected Areas -70%
- (ii) Local Government Authority where the Marine Protected Area is located- 5%
- (iii) Local Communities 10%
- (iv) Remittance to the Consolidated Fund 15%
